Deadline for receiving Senior Options home delivered meals extended to July 1st

Do you know any Franklin County residents 60 or over who are struggling to access food while we all must shelter in place?

Columbus, Ohio, May 5, 2020 - Franklin County Senior Options can help and it's easier than ever. Now through July 1, 2020, there will be no income verification required. To request home delivered meals, and other available services, call Senior Options at 614-525-6200, Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Franklin County Senior Options is a levy funded program administered by the Franklin County Office on Aging and helps Franklin County residents age 60 and older maintain their independence. It also supports family members with the often-overwhelming task of caring for a frail older parent, family member, or friend with limited abilities.

Senior Options has been providing community-based services since 1993. These services can include home-delivered meals, homemaker services, personal care, respite care, adult day care, emergency response systems and minor home repair.
